



Glenbrynth's history is a recent one. This premium Scotch whisky range was introduced into the South African market almost four years ago and is now also available in Nigeria, Namibia, Botswana, Mozambique, Swaziland, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Cameroon, Benin, Morocco, Cyprus, Iraq, UAB, Mauritius, Japan, and China.

The Glenbrynth range of Scotch consists of a threeyear-old blended Scotch, an eight-year-old pure malt blend, a 12-year-old pure malt blend, a 21-year-old single malt, a 30-year-old blended Scotch and a 40-yearold pure malt blend.

Brian says that it has been interesting to see how people have taken to Glenbrynth.
