Congratulations to Eugene du Preez for winning another silver salver for his 40 pointer he made at White River.



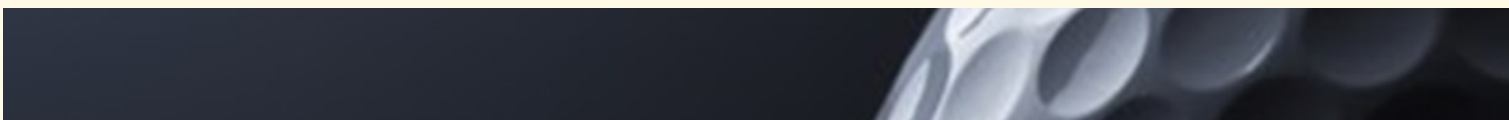

THE 2022 ANDREW MENTIS BENEFICIARIES

Vice-Captain, Johan Janse van Rensburg will present a fantastic 2022 Andrew Mentis Nomads Foundation fundraising golf day, on Sunday 13th November at White River Country Club.

This year, the Lowveld Club has selected the following beneficiaries for 2022:

Huis Bethlehem: They provide a place of safety to traumatised children. These children are removed by social workers from different social organisations and are then placed by the Children's Court in their safe care. The children aged from birth to 18 years, can stay for a short- or longer period in our houses. Since 1999, they took care of more than 400 children.



They have identified the need to upgrade the security (Cameras and motorised gates with an intercom system) in respect of both the houses in White River and Nelspruit. There is also some much needed maintenance that needs to be done to maintain the standards set in terms of the laid down CYCC requirements.

HOSPICE WHITE RIVER



White River Hospice: A non-profit Organisation (NPO), established in 2001 by The Rotary Club of White River. They specialise in quality home-based Palliative Care, which they have provided to White River Residents over the last 20 years. They have identified the development of a step-down/inpatient care facility (adjacent to Hospice House) that will focus on, and be of service to, short-term stay patients - including those suffering from conditions such as Alzheimer's and Dementia.

White River SPCA: A non-profit Organisation (NPO) whose objects include the prevention of ill treatment of animals by promoting their good treatment by man, to take cognisance of the application of laws affecting animals and to do all things reasonably necessary for, or incidental thereto. The Society performs an important health and welfare function, not only in respect of animals but also for the wider community. They identified the following project: upgrading of animal welfare facilities to enable us to provide adequate services to the community.

The annual activities culminate with a presentation to the selected Charities at the annual Andrew Mentis golf day, which is open to all Nomads, guests and potential sponsors by invitation.

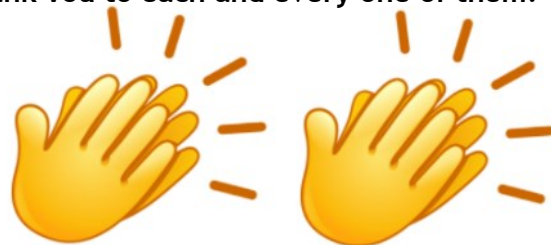
